#### Resilience Project

This week Kate England, Lisa Russell and Keelin Winterfield traveled to Melbourne to participate in *The Resilience Project* workshops. Building resilience in students has been a priority in our school over a number of years and home group and class teachers use many resources, including the 'The Resilience Project' website, to plan weekly activities to build resilience. We also try to weave a resilience mindset through our learning and assessment through activities such as writing conferencing in primary, the traffic light and goal setting processes across the school and our task feedback to SACE students with our 'achieving', 'working on' and 'where to next' conversations. Year 12 student, Lana Morrison, is completing her research project on wellbeing and resilience and has analysed long-term KIAS data which demonstrates that these approaches are beneficial to our students.
