New Communication System

We are currently using the DFE - Education Management System (EMS) to email all notices to families including any documents which require signatures from parents / caregivers, for example, excursion and camp notes and newsletters. Any notes can be signed online rather than having paper copies to be returned. Please look out for these in your emails.

We will also be accessing a function soon for families to send student absence information directly to the school (similar to the SchoolStream process) and a way of updating student information, for example, medical details.

We are taking on your feedback about the function and working to make it easier for families eg by providing a link that you can have on your phones to receive notifications but are restricted by the capabilities of the system.

Design and Technology


The main focus for students has been in promoting gratitude, empathy and mindfulness. One of the resources we have been using is The Resilience Project diary designed by Hugh van Cuylenburg. This consisted of students completing questions each day so they can grow their gratitude, empathy and mindfulness.

As an extension to this, in Design and Technology, students have been designing puzzles and toys aimed at designing with empathy. The main criteria being to design a product to be used in the classroom that can be used as bonding or calming activity. The added bonus of this task was that students had to use problem solving skills to design then make the product, additionally, students used strategies in solving the puzzle.



Students in Year 11 - Stage 1 and Year 12 Stage 2 have been making good progress in completing their work.

Year 11's have been working on engineering (metal) and furniture making (wood) tasks. Some students are working with metal in the production of toolboxes, some are using wood to make a bar stool, whilst some are using a combination of both metal and wood to make worktables. The following table and outdoor bench were completed by Year 11 students.



Year 12 students are well into their curriculum and are at the stage of designing and making their major products. These consist of a coffee table, outdoor bench seat and a tv unit.
