During maths lessons, the Yr. 4/5/6 class have been exploring measurement and strengthening their understanding of perimeter and area calculations.


The students have designed a home, calculated the area and perimeter of each room and started constructing a model of the house.

Fred - I'm proud of my build so far and proud that my pieces are fitting together well.








