BUSHFIRE SEASON

Bushfire season will start for our district on the 22/11/23. Due to our highrisk site rating, Kangaroo Inn Area School is closed on catastrophic bushfire days. This term, due to the replacement of our bushfire water tanks and pumps, we are unable to access our bushfire sprinklers and other mitigation measures if the power is out. We will be monitoring the weather conditions and the risk factors to ensure we are safe. This may mean that we are closed on days which are not catastrophic but which are risky for us to be open due to our vulnerability in a bushfire situation.

If this were to occur, we would discuss the situation with our Education Director and the Security and Emergency section of the Department for Education. We would also contact families to advise them of the possibility of a school closure and once again when the decision is made. This contact would occur via phone, and so it is extremely important that we have up to date contact numbers for your family. 





Yr. 9 Design and Technolgy Beachport Brewery Paddle Inquiry Project

Year 9 Design and Technology students have just completed the construction of "paddles" to hold tasting glasses for the Beachport Brewery. It was the perfect opportunity to engage industry, community and curriculum with students. It provided the opportunity for students to explore the "Design" process as well as sustainable innovation through inquiry as they pursued real world authentic learning opportunities and developed a sense of ownership to their community.

In the creation of their product, students researched designs, and collaborated and communicated with each other to create prototypes. They used numeracy concepts such as number and geometry, as well literacy, procedural concepts throughout the making process. Students incorporated sustainable options such as using donated recycled redgum boards. Millicent High School kindly offered the use of their laser cutter to print the Beachport Brewery logo on the paddles.





Design brief-

A local Brewery has asked us to design a paddle that will hold 4 glasses.

The total length required is 470mm. We allow for extra length if you would like to

add a handle.

The holes need to be 80mm in between centers.

The holes need to be 60 mm in diameter.

The distance from the table to the base of the board needs to be 40 mm.

They need to be finished with 3 coats of varnish. Sand between coat 1 and 2.

Evaluation-



We enjoyed being able to make something for the community which we might get to use one day.



Forgot your username


Select the Forgot Password option.




This will take the user to the reset credentials page, select Forgot your username? option




When you select the **Forgot your username** link, you will be requested to enter your email address. This is the email address your Community Portal invitation was sent too.

Follow the Forgot password steps using the username provided.





Enter the username you created (you can ask your school what your username is if you have forgotten it, or you can follow the 'forgot your username' options)




The **Reset Credentials** window will come up advising you will receive an email with instructions on how to reset the password.


