This year, KIAS have committed to working alongside The Resilience Project – an intervention program committed to teaching positive mental health strategies to prevent mental ill-health and build young people's capacity to deal with adversity.

Over the course of 2024, teachers and students will engage in weekly lessons and activities around the key principles of Gratitude, Empathy, Mindfulness (GEM), and Emotional Literacy to build resilience. The program covers all year levels and has catered lessons suited to the various age groups we have within the school.

Play is the Way in the Year 2/3 Class


Play is the Way is a methodology for social and emotional learning. At the beginning of each year, primary classes explore the Play is the Way (PITW) concepts through a series of posters.

We made a class book on the 'Golden Rule' to share with the Rec/1 and Year 4/5/6 classes.








This is what being brave and participating looks like in our class:
